



MANAGEMENT OF KEPONG SENTRAL STATION PARKING AREA IS TO BE IMPROVED

SEPANG, 14 December 2022 – Railway Assets Corporation (RAC)-appointed parking management operator Matrix Parking Solution Sdn. Bhd. will improve parking management at Kepong Sentral Station.

This commitment was assured by the operator from a site visit with the Corporation on 11 December 2022 (Sunday), a day after The Star's 10 December 2022 (Saturday) report on the unpleasant conditions of the railway station, including its parking area. Among the complaints made by the local residents were that the parking area is riddled with potholes, gutters covered with undergrowth, street lights and closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras were not functioning, no security guards in sight and the path of the covered walkway has damaged tiles and littered with old furniture and luggage.

The site visit was made to observe and closely examine the aforementioned conditions. As an initial step, maintenance works had been carried out on 12 December 2022 by the existing maintenance panel contractor.

The operator informed that among the measures that will be taken to improve the parking lot management include:

1. The frequency of maintenance and repair works will be increased from once every three months to once a month;
2. Installation of CCTV will complete in a month;
3. Maintenance of fences/ drains/ lighting of the parking area will be done every month; and

4. Installation of barrier gate will take 14 days.

RAC has made the appointed operators responsible for the operation and maintenance of the parking lot for each train station. In this regard, monitoring of these operators will be made from time to time.

On a 13 December 2022 visit with Keretapi Tanah Melayu Berhad (KTMB), Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) and The Star reporter, DBKL informed to be in charge for the repair works for potholes and bushes at the entrance to the station as the area is not of RAC's jurisdiction.
