



MAINTENANCE WORK AT SEREMBAN RAILWAY STATION IS NOW COMPLETED

SEPANG, 4 January 2023 – Railway Assets Corporation (RAC) through the appointed parking operator, My Box Park Sdn. Bhd. has carried out clearing works at the parking area of Seremban Railway Station beginning 1 January 2023.

This feedback is in response to a report by Mr. Samuel Yesuiah through The Star dated 29 December 2022 on the highlighted issues such as overgrown vegetation at the area, sharp bend and narrow route towards the exit of the parking lot and potholed road at the entrance of the parking lot.

As for the sharp bend and other issues raised by the complainant, these matters will be coordinated with the upgrade works at the station which will begin in the middle of the month.

RAC has appointed My Box Park Sdn. Bhd. to operate 11 parking lot areas for railway stations in Negeri Sembilan until April 2024. Other than Seremban Railway Station parking area, the operator has also scheduled gradual maintenance work for the remaining railway stations of Negeri Sembilan.

RAC is working closely with parking operators to ensure all railway stations are well maintained for the comfort and safety of all commuters.
