



KEPONG SENTRAL STATION FACILITY MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR WORKS TO BE CARRIED OUT COMMENCING TOMORROW

SEPANG, 11 December 2022 – Railway Assets Corporation (RAC) will carry out facility maintenance and repair works at Kepong Sentral Station tomorrow (12 December 2022) beginning with parking lot maintenance work.

This is following a report by The Star on 10 December 2022 (Saturday) from a complaint made by Kepong community activist Yee Poh Ping who revealed that the parking area at the station is riddled with potholes that the local residents had covered with wooden planks as temporary measure. Apart from that, the drains are covered with undergrowth, the streetlights and closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras are malfunctioning, no security guards in sight and the path along the covered walkway is observed with damaged tiles and is littered with old furniture and baggage.

Following the complaint, RAC has conducted a site visit on 11 December 2022 (Sunday) to observe and closely examine the damage at the area. As the initial step, parking lot maintenance work will be performed by the existing panel contractor tomorrow. Other repair and maintenance works will be made as soon as the cost estimation and appointment of contractor are finalised.

This Corporation would like to thank the local residents for highlighting this issue. RAC appreciates all complaints made and takes all comments positively for this Corporation to be able to provide the best service to rail users.
